*Taking good care of your permanent cosmetics is crucial to achieving the best results.

Approved ointments for your permanent cosmetics are:

- Vaseline
- A + D original Ointment
- Aquaphor Healing Ointment (not cream).
- · Grape Seed oil

DO NOT USE: Neosporin or Coconut oil. This will take the pigment placed away.

After Care Instructions Eye Brows:

- Please apply after care ointment for 7-10 days.
- Do not let your brows get dry or crusty
- Some swelling, redness or itching is normal and to be expected 3-5 days after procedure.
- Only apply ointment with a clean q tip 3 to 4 times a day. Do not use fingers.
- Avoid sun exposure, pools, and direct water pressure.
- Do not pick or rub the area.
- Do not wear any makeup on area for the first 72 hours after the procedure.

*Brows will oxidize and get darker before they soften in the healing process, this is normal.

After Care Instructions for Eyeliner and/or Eyelash Enhancement:

- Eyes may be tender, swollen, and possibly bruised for up to 3 to 5 days after procedure. This is normal.
- You may experience itching. This is all part of the healing process.
- Apply approved ointment with a q tip one time in AM and one time in PM. Do not use your fingers.
- Do not let your eyeliner dry out the first 72 hours after procedure.

- Avoid sun exposure, hot tubs, direct water pressure, and any eye cream for the first 72 hours after procedure.
- Do not rub or pick area. You may experience some flaking. This is normal.

Lip After Care Instructions:

- Lips will feel very dry and swollen after treatment. They will feel very "chapped". This is very normal.
- Apply approved ointments several times a day for 12-14 days after procedure with a q-tip. Do not use fingers.
- Avoid exposure to sun, pools, and direct water pressure for 14 days after procedure.
- Do not rub or pick areas.
- For about 72 hours after procedure, just use water to brush your teeth.
- You can resume wearing lipstick after your lips are healed.
- Lips heal in 3 stages: too dark, too light, and just right. This takes about a month time for this to happen.
- Your lips may need 1-3 touch up appointments depending on the way your lips retain pigment.
